#### MINUTES OF REGULAR MEETING MONTGOMERY COUNTY MUNICIPAL UTILITY DISTRICT NO. 121

August 19, 2019

The Board of Directors ("Board") of Montgomery County Municipal Utility District No. 121 ("District") met in regular session, open to the public, on August 19, 2019, at The Woodforest Golf Club, 1199 Fish Creek Thoroughfare, Montgomery, Texas, outside the boundaries of the District, and the roll was called of the members of the Board:

and all of the above were present except Directors Pell and LaPlant, thus constituting a quorum.

Also present at all or part of the meeting were: Tony Scott of Gray & Pape Heritage Management ("Gray & Pape"); Tiana Smith of Waste Management ("WM"); Chris Uzelmeier of Montgomery County Municipal Utility District No. 113; Stephen Eustis of Robert W. Baird & Co. ("R.W. Baird"); Virgil Yoakum and Stephen Barrera of Woodforest Development, Inc. ("WDI"); Mike Williams of Municipal Operations & Consulting, Inc. ("MOC"); David Patterson of Assessments of the Southwest, Inc.; Victoria Mundie of LJA Engineering ("LJA"); Erin Garcia of Myrtle Cruz, Inc. ("MC"); and Rich Muller, Kene Chinweze, and Amy N. Love of The Muller Law Group, PLLC ("MLG").

#### PUBLIC COMMENTS

Director Fullerton opened the meeting to receive public comments.

There being no public comments, Director Fullerton closed the meeting to public comments.

#### **MINUTES**

The Board considered approving the minutes of the July 15, 2019, meeting. After review and discussion, Director Bleibdrey moved to approve the minutes of the July 15, 2019, meeting. Director Beard seconded the motion, which passed by unanimous vote.

#### LEGISLATIVE REPORT

Mr. Chinweze reviewed a memorandum regarding the 2019 Texas Legislation affecting municipal utility districts. No Board action was taken.

#### ORDER AMENDING AND RESTATING RECORDS MANAGEMENT PROGRAM

Mr. Chinweze presented an Order Establishing Records Management Policy and Amending and Restating the District's Records Management Program ("Order") incorporating the Texas State Library and Archives Commission's recommended form policy and record retention schedules. Following review and discussion, Director Bleibdrey moved to adopt the Order. Director Beard seconded the motion, which passed unanimously.

#### REPORT ON DEVELOPMENT

Mr. Barrera reported on development in the District and Woodforest, including year-to-date homes sales, commercial development, and community marketing events. No Board action was taken.

# 2019 TAX RATE, SET PUBLIC HEARING, AND AUTHORIZE NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING REGARDING ADOPTION OF TAX RATE

The Board considered setting a date for a public hearing on the District's 2019 tax rate. Mr. Eustis distributed and reviewed correspondence from R.W. Baird recommending the Board adopt a total tax rate of \$0.99 per \$100 of assessed valuation, all to provide for the District's maintenance and operations obligations. A copy of the correspondence is attached. After review and discussion, Director Bleibdrey moved to set a public hearing to adopt the recommended tax rate on Monday, September 16, 2019, at 11:00 a.m. at the District's regular meeting place and to authorize the tax assessor/collector to publish notice of the same. Director Beard seconded the motion, which carried unanimously.

### TAX ASSESSMENT AND COLLECTION MATTERS

Mr. Patterson distributed and reviewed the monthly tax assessor/collector's report, including checks presented for approval, a copy of which is attached. He reported that the District's 2018 taxes were 100% collected as of July 30, 2019. Following review and discussion, Director Bleibdrey moved to approve the tax assessor/collector's report, including payment of the tax bills listed in the report. Director Beard seconded the motion, which passed by unanimous vote.

#### FINANCIAL AND BOOKKEEPING MATTERS

Ms. Garcia distributed and reviewed the bookkeeper's report, a copy of which is attached. She also reviewed and requested the Board approve the Annual Financial Report. Following review and discussion, Director Bleibdrey moved to approve the bookkeeper's report and Annual Financial Report. Director Beard seconded the motion, which passed unanimously.

#### **ENGINEERING MATTERS**

Ms. Mundie presented and reviewed the engineer's report, a copy of which is attached. She requested approval of engineering proposals and authorization to design the following projects:

- water, sanitary sewer, and drainage facilities to serve Woodforest, Section 83;
- 2. water, sanitary sewer, and drainage facilities to serve Woodforest, Section 102; and
- 3. lift station no. 6.

Ms. Mundie requested the Board approve the plans and specifications and authorize LJA to advertise and receive bids for water, sanitary, and drainage facilities to serve Central Pine Street Extension (Roundabout to Woodforest, Section 102).

Ms. Mundie requested the Board approve pay applications and/or change orders for the following construction projects:

- 1. water, sewer, and drainage facilities to serve Central Pine Street Extension (Woodforest Ditch 4P to Woodforest, Section 77;
- 2. water, sewer, and drainage facilities to serve Woodforest, Section 76; and
- 3. water, sewer, and drainage facilities to serve Pine Island at Woodforest, Section 3.

Ms. Mundie then recommended the Board accept the following offsite easement for Woodforest, Section 90:

- 1. Storm Sewer and Drainage Easement for 0.027 acres;
- 2. Storm Sewer and Drainage Easement for 0.063 acres; and
- 2. Temporary Storm Sewer and Drainage Easement for 0.10 acres.

After review and discussion and based on the engineer's recommendation, Director Beard moved to approve the engineer's report, including all recommended action items highlighted in the engineer's report. Director Bleibdrey seconded the motion, which passed by unanimous vote.

Mr. Scott introduced himself to the Board and reviewed a draft archaeological survey from Gray & Pape. He stated that the survey recommends the District have additional deep testing performed. Discussion ensued, and the Board requested Mr. Yoakum meet with Mr. Scott to determine scope for testing, testing sites and schedule for testing.

#### **OPERATION OF DISTRICT FACILITIES**

Mr. Williams presented and reviewed the monthly operations report from MOC, a copy of which is attached. Following review and discussion, Director Beard moved to approve the operator's report. Director Bleibdrey seconded the motion, which passed by unanimous vote.

#### ADOPTION OF AMENDED RATE ORDER

The Board considered amending the District's Rate Order. Following review and discussion, Director Bleibdrey moved to adopt the amended Rate Order. Director Beard seconded the motion, which passed by unanimous vote.

#### GARBAGE COLLECTION REPORT, INCLUDING ANNUAL CPI ADJUSTMENT

Ms. Smith introduced herself to the Board and reviewed a letter from WM regarding the annual rate adjustment pursuant to the District's Municipal Solid Waste Collection and Transportation Agreement with WM, a copy of which is attached. Mr. Muller noted that the rate for garbage collection will increase from \$19.23 to \$19.89 per month per connection, effective October 1, 2019. The Board took no action regarding amending the District's Rate Order to increase rates.

#### ANNEXATION OF LAND INTO THE DISTRICT

The Board discussed the possibility of annexing property into the District. Mr. Muller stated that Trendmaker Development Company would like to have approximately 52.268 acres annexed into the District. Following review and discussion, Director Bleibdrey move to approve the annexation letter agreement and authorize LJA to commence work on a feasibility study. Director Beard seconded the motion, which passed by unanimous vote.

The Montgomery Central Appraisal District has recently certified the 2019 value for your district at \$2,454,810. Based on the District's current budget, we are recommending the Board of Directors consider levying a 2019 tax rate of \$0.99 per \$100 of assessed valuation for maintenance and operational purposes.

Upon issuance of the District's initial bonds, future tax rates will be a combination of a debt service tax rate and a maintenance tax rate totaling \$0.99 per \$100 of assessed valuation. By levying the tax rate of \$0.99 per \$100 of assessed valuation at this time allows any current and future residents to qualify for mortgages and budget for the District's tax rate through the development.

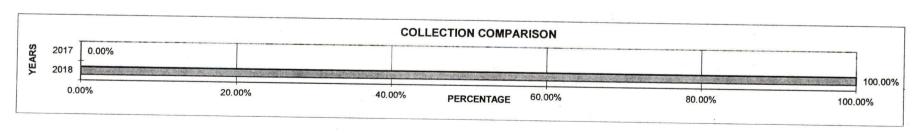
